IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT 902-1990 LOUISIANA LEGISLATION

In accordance with Act 902 of the 1990 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature, new requirements are in effect relative to the operations of third party administrators in the State of Louisiana.

Any person acting as the third party administrator of a health and accident or medical benefit plan, program, policy, etc. covering residents of Louisiana must file with this Department a notarized statement identifying said person as a third party administrator. This statement must also include the administrator's valid mailing address and information pertaining to the specific type of plan(s) administered. Any person who administers self-insured programs regulated pursuant to RS22:3001-3017 is obligated to obtain a self-insurer Certificate of Authority before providing coverage in Louisiana.

Third party administrators should be in compliance with this directive prior to commencing any business activities in this state.

This directive supersedes and replaces Louisiana Insurance Directive No. 50 issued August 21, 1984.
